Upper Endoscopy Preparation

Checklist

- Do not take aspirin, iron tablets, or any blood-thinning medications at least five (5) days prior to the procedure.
- Do not take insulin or anti-diabetes medications the morning of your upper endoscopy. Let your doctor know about your medications.
- If you take a blood thinner called Coumadin, let your doctor know.
- Bring your medications with you on the day of the procedure so that you can take them after the procedure.
- If you have prosthesis, artificial heart valves, heart murmur, arterial graft, or have required prophylactic antibiotics in the past, please let the doctor know in advance.
- **Do not eat or drink after midnight the night before the test.**
- **Arrive at least one (1) hour before your scheduled time to allow for pre-procedure preparations.**
- You must have someone drive you home after the procedure (spouse, parent, child, relative, or friend). You cannot take a cab, bus, limo, bike, or walk.
